**The Finnish Association of Building Owners and Construction Clients  
RAKLI**

RAKLI is an interest group and trade association representing the most prominent real estate owners, investors and service providers in Finland.

In 2002, the membership comprises nearly 500 private and public real estate companies, investors, owner-occupants, management companies, service providers and shopping centres. The members of RAKLI own more than 50 % of the Finnish commercial property, and nearly 90 % of the income-producing commercial property.

RAKLI represents its members in various property ownership matters concerning e.g. legislation, taxation and common policies.
